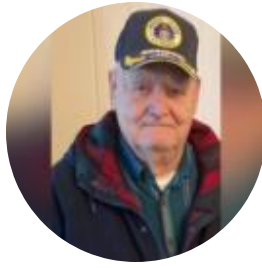

Raymond J. Tadder, age 97, of Pittsburgh, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, September 24, 2024. Raymond was born on July 3, 1927, the son of the late Raymond and Nellie Tadder.
