Barbara “Bobbie” Shock, age 93, longtime resident of Castle Shannon, passed away peacefully in the comfort of her home on Friday, August 30, 2024, surrounded by the love of her family. Bobbie was born on March 4, 1931, in Pittsburgh, the daughter of the late Daniel and Magdaline Flanagan.

Bobbie is the loving mother of Diane S. (Jim) Johnson, Judith A. (Ken) Wolfe, John B. (Val) Shock, Patricia Bosko, Pamela Decker (Jerry Norris), and Mark V. (Angel) Shock.
