David (Dave) C. Zeiler, age 83, of Fredericksburg, VA, formerly of Pittsburgh, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 28, 2024. Dave was born on July 13, 1940, the son of the late Carl and Velma (Ordos) Zeiler.

Devoted and beloved husband of 54 years to Kathleen (Eberley) Zeiler;

Beloved father to Christine (William) Benz of Alexandria, Virginia; grandfather of Cecelia and Lauren Benz;

Dave graduated from Clairton High School in 1958 and joined the United States Marine Corp, stationed at Camp Lejeune, NC from 1958-1961. A graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, Dave obtained a degree in business. As a resident of South Park, he and Kathy were parishioners at Nativity Parish before moving to the Washington, DC area in 1992. He later concluded his accounting career with the Department of Veterans Affairs in Washington, DC and enjoyed retirement on Lake Anna, VA.

Dave was an outdoorsman who loved cutting firewood, playing softball and boating. At home, he enjoyed "putzing" around, especially in the garage or yard. Dave and Kathy spent much of their retirement traveling and hosting friends and family at their lake house.
