Lawrence “Larry” Marchetti, age 92, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 23, 2023, surrounded by his loving family in the comfort of his own home. Larry was born on February 6, 1931, the son of the late Lawrence and Dorothy (Deakin) Marchetti.

Larry was the dedicated husband of 69 years to Alice Mae (Young) Marchetti; the loving father of William Michael (Kathi) Marchetti and Lawrence Daniel (Lisa) Marchetti; cherished grandfather of Tiffany, Brittny, Eli, Klorissa, and Mason; and the proud great grandfather to a multitude of great-grandchildren.
