**W**illiam J. Lowe passed away at the age of 71 on December 18, 2023, in his hometown of Pittsburgh, where he was born on July 20, 1952.

William is survived by his son, Jonathan Lowe and his fur babies, Lennox and Sahari whom William adored; as well as many cousins and countless friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Dorothy Lowe; his brother, David A. Lowe, and son, William J. Lowe, Jr.

Proudly serving his country, William was an Army veteran of the Vietnam era. He spent many years as a dedicated school bus driver for the Chartier Valley School District.
