Freda (Misura) Horgas, of West Mifflin, began her peaceful journey on Thursday, March 16, 2023.

She will leave a deep hole in the hearts of her children Audean (Berkley) Godehn, Blaise (Lori) Horgas, and especially her grandchildren Lauren and Bradley Horgas. She is also survived by her nieces and nephews (including great and great-great) along with her dear friends Ronald "Ping" Stagon and Rich Toner. She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 51 years, William "Bill" Horgas, parents Barney and Stella Misura, sister Loretta Dimperio, brothers Chester J., Edwin and Donald Misura.
