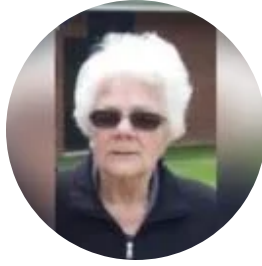

She is preceded in death by her husband George Paxon Sr.; brothers Clyde Stearns, William Payne and Duane Stearns.

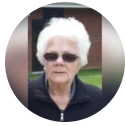
Dolores loved to go to the mountains, enjoyed camping and bingo, and loved traveling to New York to see her grandchildren. She faithfully read her bible everyday.
