We did manage to laugh and continue to create memories: your 80th Birthday and returning to Cape May, our Christmas in Deep Creek, girls trips, gambling, thirfting.... Our family reunion at my house this summer and our last girls trip the weekend before you died to Old Town and MGM. You had us out to 2am. I honestly enjoyed time spent with my 86 year old mom over most others. I knew one day You would leave me but not now maybe in 5 or 6 years, even then would be too soon. You had more to experience with your family, Tyler and Makayla getting married, you officially becoming a great grandma. It's a boy and 2 beautiful girls.
