William "Bill" R. Campbell, age 90, of Pittsburgh, formerly of Altoona, died on October 16, 2021, after a short battle with cancer.

Born August 18, 1931, in Altoona, a son of the late William M. and Esther C. (McConahy) Campbell

William is survived by his siblings, Bernard "Bernie" Campbell (Dolores), Alice C. Swab (Ted), and Laura Jean McKinney (Wilbur), Sister-in-law, Marge Campbell; 10 nieces and nephews; special friends, Patrick and Carol Haver; and his furry friends, Danny Boy and Gazebo.
