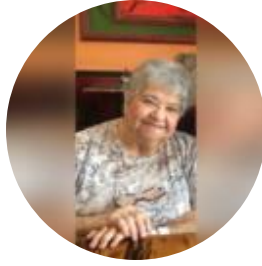

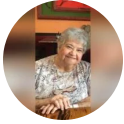
Carol was a retired retail manager for Burlington Coat Factory.

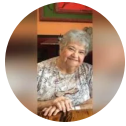

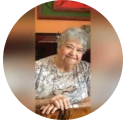
