Age 87, of Baltimore Maryland died July 25, 2020 at the Maryland Masonic Home. A former resident of West Mifflin, PA, she moved to Florida in 2004 and was an active member of the Episcopal Church, the White Shrine of Jerusalem and a former member of the Eastern Star. While living in Florida, she cooked for Meals on Wheels and helped her neighbors in need. Elaine was an avid golfer and Christmas Cookie Baker. The Baltimore Sun selected her Chocolate Carmel Thumbprint as one of the top 10 winners of the 2012 Holiday Cookie Contest. In 2017, Elaine relocated to Baltimore, Maryland full time to be near her daughters.
