James Joseph Hagan, 84, of Pittsburgh, beloved husband of Margaret Ellen (Husar), died peacefully surrounded by family at his home on Saturday, July 25, 2020.

Faith and family was of utmost importance in his life. The strong faith he had was shared with all until his last breath.

A lifelong resident of Pittsburgh, Mr. Hagan was born on October 19, 1935, the son of the late Bernard and Ellen (Boylan) Hagan.

Mr. Hagan worked for more than 35 years for the Pittsburgh Press/Pittsburgh Post Gazette where he spent the majority of his career as advertising production manager.
