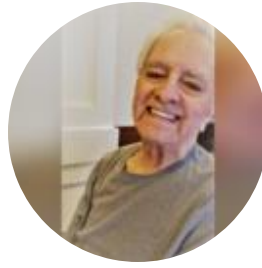

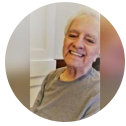


Jack V. Bisbey
