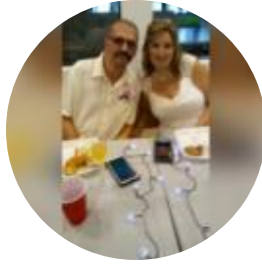

Edward had three nephews that he adored, Brandon Anthony, Sebastien Anthony and Stevie Carroll.

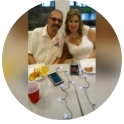

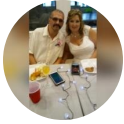
