Florence B. Burns, 93, died peacefully in South Pymatuning Township, Sharpsville, PA on Sunday (December 29, 2019) where she was residing with her daughter and family for the past year. Formerly she lived her entire life in the South Hills area of Pittsburgh. She was born May 19, 1926 to Henry and Elizabeth (Brindle) Enders on Timberland Avenue in what was known then as West Liberty Boro, Pittsburgh, PA.

She is predeceased by her husband Philip N. Burns to whom she was married on September 30, 1947 at the Church of the Advent in Pittsburgh, PA. They celebrated their 50th anniversary in 1997 just months before Phil's passing on December 10, 1997.

Florence graduated from Dormont High School and did clerical work until the birth of her first child, then took time to be a homemaker. After raising her children, she was employed as a Certified Nurse's Assistant for many years and retired from Asbury Heights in 1993.
