LTC Robert J. Katelan, USAR, age 96, of Baldwin, went to be with his Lord and Savior on February 24, 2019. He is survived by his beloved wife of 54 years, Beverly J. (Schell) Katelan; brother-in-law, Kenneth (Audrey) Schell; sister-in-law, Gloria (the late Theodore) Schell; as well as many nieces, nephews, and friends. Bob honorably served his nation in World War II, and was present for the Battle of the Bulge.
