Geraldine F. Evans, 97, formerly of South Park, died October 15, 2017 at Jameson Care Center, New Castle. Born February 7, 1920, she was a daughter of August and Elizabeth Fest. She married Walter S. Evans in August 1943 and he preceded her in death. She was a '42 graduate of Carnegie Tech and earned a Bachelors degree in Home Economics. She worked as a home demonstrator of appliances and was an accomplished seamstress. She crafted vestments for priests, and at age 80 made her granddaughter's wedding gown.
