Ronald Frank Urbansky, 83, of Pittsburgh, PA., formerly of Dravosburg, PA., passed away on January 21, 2025. Born on December 6, 1941, the day before Pearl Harbor, to the late Frank and Marie Urbansky.

Ron dedicated 37 years of his life to serving his community as a respected postmaster, a position appointed to him by Congress. His commitment to service was evident through his 4 years in the army, a time he always reflected on with honor.

Ron's favorite place was at his cabin at Tionesta, PA, where he had the pleasure of living for 5 cherished years. He cherished times hunting with his sons, grandson, nephew, other family members and friends. He loved working on cars, from minor repairs to replacing entire engines.

A history enthusiast, Ron was a patriot in every sense, living a life guided by the enduring principles of God, country, and family. Above all, Ron's happiest days were spent with his beloved family. 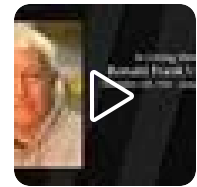
