Howard H. LaFianza, age 89, passed away in the comfort of his home on Monday, January 27, 2025, just nine days following the passing of his beloved wife of 66 years, Rita. Howard was born in Pittsburgh on May 18, 1935, the son of the late Peter and Anna LaFianza.

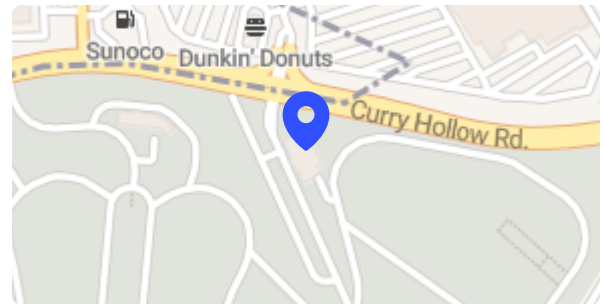

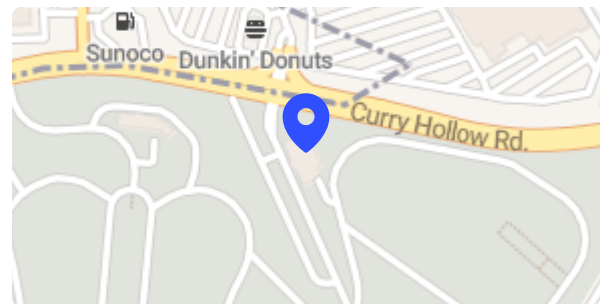
