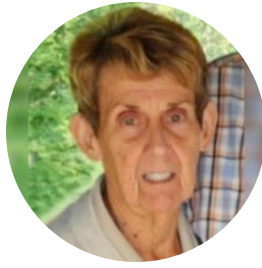

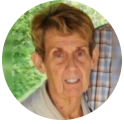
Susan worked to support her household and ultimately found joy in the simple pleasures of life, taking pride in the warmth of her home, which she kept impeccably clean.
