Born on September 10, 1944, in Tallahassee, Florida, Clayton dedicated his life to caring for others as a registered nurse, a vocation that showcased his compassion and dedication to the well-being of those around him.

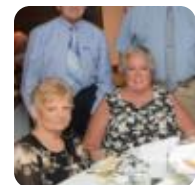
