Annie Mae Williamson Sedore, beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and devoted friend, passed away peacefully on April 25, 2025 at the age of 103.

Born in Huntsville, Alabama, Annie was raised in Hollywood, Florida. In 1943, she married US Army Air Force Sergeant Michael Sedore in Boca Raton, Florida. After World War II, they settled in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, ultimately sharing 56 years and five children.

Throughout her life, Annie loved to work. Whether in her role as administrative assistant for Family Counseling Agency in Tucson, Arizona, or later as volunteer at Banner Baywood Hospital, she brought skill, warmth, and dedication that made a lasting difference in the lives of many.
