Sandy Hartner Weiss, age 59, of Pittsburgh, PA passed away peacefully on April 17, 2026, at UPMC Mercy Hospital. Born on December 5, 1966, in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of the late Jim and Lois (Lutz) Hartner.

Sandy grew up in Carrick. Her life's work was serving the Lord, and she worked most recently as the Discipleship Director at North Way Christian Community Church - Dormont.

Sandy was one of God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved; clothed with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. (Colossians 3:12).
